



GCSE Results 2026 – Press Release

Testbourne Community School is pleased to congratulate the Class of 2026 on their excellent GCSE and vocational award results. Three quarters of students achieved a 'standard' pass of grade 4 or higher in both English and Maths. The number of students achieving a 'strong' pass of grade 5 or higher in English and Maths increased compared to 2025, as did the overall number of grade 9s awarded, with 78 grade 9s issued to our students across all subjects. Many of our subjects secured excellent pass rates of 75% or higher this year, including Art, Art Photography, Biology, Chemistry, Design & Technology, English Language, English Literature, Geography, History, Maths, Music, PE, and Physics.

We are proud that so many of our students have shown independence, resilience and responsibility throughout their time at Testbourne, and this has been reflected in the progress they have made. There were many happy students and their families celebrating their results with us today. They are looking forward to progressing onto the next chapter of their education this September.
